

SOUTH PACIFIC GAMES - Suva, July 2003 ATHLETICS COMPETITION - FULL RESULTS

On the first day of competition - 7th July - the weather conditions were exceptionally bad with driving rain and severe headwinds which are not reflected in the official wind readings. The auto timing malfunctioned during the Men's 100m, and was totally out of action later in the programme. This accounts for the mixture of fully automatic and hand times. The bad weather conditions and the malfunctioning of the auto-timing system continued on 8th July. While the weather conditions improved somewhat after that, and the auto timing functioned properly, there were still gusty negative winds throughout the competition.

Kristy SLADE of Samoa was challenged and found to be ineligible. She appealed against that decision and was allowed to compete until her appeal had been heard. She lost the appeal and her performance has been deleted from the official records. That performance is listed below.

Other athletes to be excluded from the competition because they were found to be ineligible were -
Lisa Misipeka (ASA) – who competed in the Mini South Pacific Games (Pago Pago 1997) and the South Pacific Games (Guam 1999) without being challenged. She has represented American Samoa at the Olympic Games (1996 & 2000) and won the W HT bronze medal in the World Championships in 1999.
Kelsey Nakanelua (ASA) – who represented American Samoa at the 2000 Olympic Games.

The Games Charter (soon to be revised) specifically deals with eligibility. Those born in the island Country / Territory that they want to represent must have “resided in his Country or Territory for at least 5 years”. Expatriates are eligible to represent a Country / Territory provided that they have “resided in

that Country / Territory for a period of four (4) years immediately prior to the closing date for individual entries”.

The FIJI Women’s 4 x 400m relay team was disqualified (Rule 170.18) for substituting a runner after the final submission of the team composition and running order. A runner named on the official starting list, and the result sheet, did not actually run, her place being taken by another runner.

The team won the race in the time of 3:40.03 (Vatureba, Bulikiobo, Radiniwaiwaro, Raluve) - a new Games Record, South Pacific Best and Fiji National Record.

At the time of writing the Team Fiji management is seeking to have the disqualification overturned in the Court of Arbitration. If it is overturned the result will be amended and the medal table corrected. (The Fiji Team never went through with their appeal and the result stands).

The Men’s 3000m Steeplechase was run over (approx) 3400m. It is hoped to obtain a video of the race and give approximate hand timings for the participants in the race.
